## Inaugural event to celebrate “Angels Amongst Us” to be held at Merrimack Valley Golf Club, February 19 Proceeds to benefit Massachusetts-based Brain Aneurysm Foundation

(Hanover, MA, - February 9, 2016) Family and friends of Lynn Wareing, who died last year from a brain aneurysm, will hold the inaugural “Angels Amongst Us” event on Friday, February 19, 2016 at Merrimack Valley Golf Club in Methuen, MA. at 7 p.m.

A resident of Lawrence, MA, Wareing died on September 13, 2015 at the age of 49. A nurse at the Parkland Medical Center in Derry, New Hampshire, Wareing was one of the estimated 30, 000 people in the United States that are affected every year by brain aneurysms.

All proceeds from this inaugural fundraiser will be donated in memory of Lynn Wareing—along with other “Angels Amongst Us” including Catherine Williams, Angelo Lagana, Eli Vasquez, Francis Hilario, and Alfred E. Hechemy who also died from this disease. The funds will benefit the Brain Aneurysm Foundation (BAF), a nationally and internationally renowned non-profit organization based in Massachusetts for their work in raising awareness about brain aneurysms as well as for their support of Arterial Vascular Medical research.

“The work of the Brain Aneurysm Foundation is to get resources to those doctors and researchers who are working to cure this disease,” said Christine Buckley, BAF Executive Director, “The impact of our work greatly depends on the success of fundraising events like the one hosted by the friends and family of Lynn Wareing. Our goal as an organization is to raise awareness and end the fear of this devastating disease.”

Tickets for The “Angels Amongst Us” event are \$25 per person. In addition to food, and a cash bar, music will be provided by the George Williams Band.
