




FINANCIAL SUMMARY

Since 1994, when the Brain Aneurysm Foundation was established as a public charity, our funding has been targeted to provide critical awareness, education, support, advocacy, and research funding to reduce the incidence of brain aneurysms, promote early detection, and improve patient outcomes.

The foundation has no endowment. Every dollar we raise is deployed to advance our mission to create wider awareness of brain aneurysms; to provide support for those affected by brain aneurysms; and to educate patients, their families, and the medical community about brain aneurysms. From year to year, the foundation strives to maintain its low overhead through vigilant governance of expenses and constant review of nonprofit best practices and methodologies.

WHAT WE DO

Awareness

The Brain Aneurysm Foundation stives to raise awareness through many different outlets throughout the year. With the cancelation of events due to COVID-19, social media became our largest source of spreading awareness in 2020. Through our active presence on multiple social media channels, we were able to raise awareness about brain aneurysms, educate the public about symptoms and risk factors and also generate support for federal policies and funding that will benefit those affected by brain aneurysms.

Education

In 2020 the Brain Aneurysm Foundation (BAF) continued collaboration with DBC Pri-Med LLC to educate primary care physicians (PCP) to help them identify the early warning signs and symptoms of a brain aneurysm rupture. Due to COVID we could not have any live lectures, however, our webcast was shown througout the year and approximately 4,000 physicians took part.




Support

A support group provides a continuum of care for survivors, providing vital support to them, their families, and other loved ones throughout their recovery. The Brain Aneurysm Foundation works with hospitals and other healthcare organizations to establish high-quality support groups. There are now more than 75 foundation-approved support groups in the United States and Canada.

Research

2020 brought many challenges for the foundation including lost revenue from canceled events, but not funding our annual research grants was NOT an option! Brain aneurysms still occur and funding is still needed. During our first ever Virtual Research Grant Symposium, the Brain Aneurysm Foundation awarded \$375,000 in research grants to 10 recipients. Since its inception, the foundation — the largest private funder of brain aneurysm research in the nation — has distributed more than \$3.5 million in research grants.



Advocacy

Due to COVID-19, we weren't able to meet with members of congess at our Annual Advocacy Day on Capitol Hill, but we were able to continue our advocacy efforts by launching our new P2A advocacy platform. By August we had garnered representation from all 50 states and Ellie's Law gained bipartisan support in the House and Senate and continued to gain co-sponsors.
