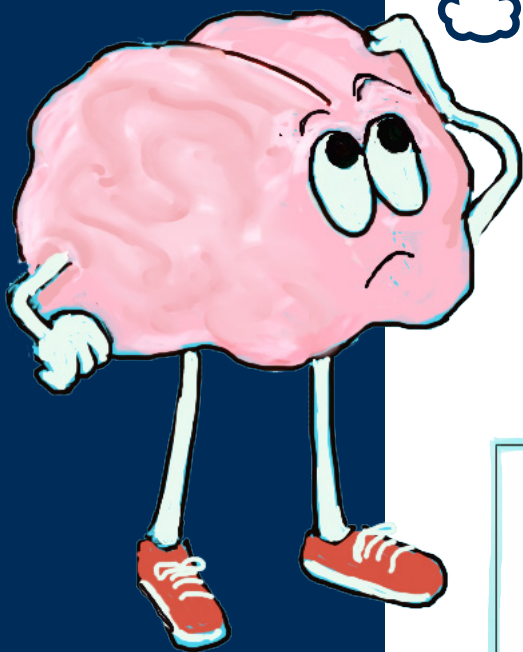

## What is a brain aneurysm?

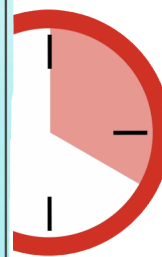


A brain aneurysm is a weak bulging spot on the wall of a brain artery very much like a thin balloon or weak spot on an inner tube.

### 6 Warning Signs

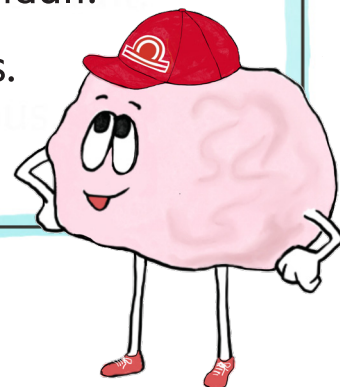
- Localized headache
- Dilated pupils
- Blurred or double vision
- Pain above or behind the eye
- Weakness or numbness
- Difficulty speaking
